- Stay straight to go onto Boylston Ave E.
- Take the first left onto E Roanoke St.
- Turn right onto 10th Ave E.
- Turn left onto E Aloha St.
- Turn right onto 21st Ave E.
- SWS/ World Family Center is on the right.

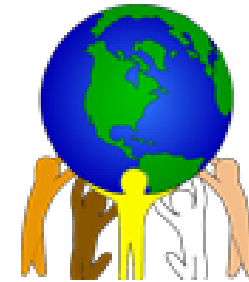
From I-5 Going North

- Take the Olive Way exit, Exit 166
- Turn slight right onto Olive Way.
- Olive way becomes E John St.
- Turn left onto 15th Ave E.
- Take the first right onto E Thomas St.
- Turn left onto 19th Ave E.
- Turn right onto E republican St.
- Take the second right onto 21st Ave E.
- SWS/ World Family Center is on the right

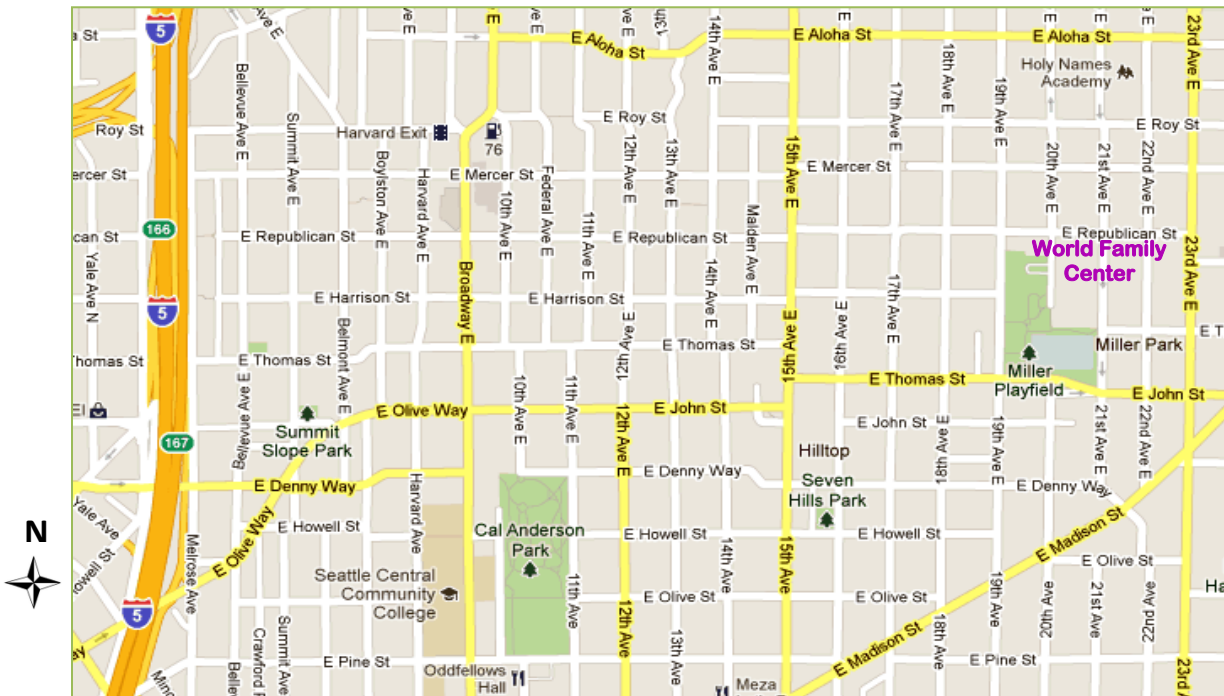
