
Academic Growth & Student Outcomes

Family/Staff Climate & Engagement



School Mission Statement

North Beach strives to nurture and empower all students to reach their full potential as learners and as citizens. We help our students show consistent academic growth in reading, writing, and math by using differentiated educational strategies and encouraging an atmosphere of respect and collaboration among staff and community.

School Goals


- At least 80% of students make gains on the MSP state reading test, an increase from 69% in 2010.
- At least 80% of students make gains on the MSP state math test, an increase from 64% in 2010.
- At least 80% of students meet or exceed state writing standards on the MSP writing test, an increase from 70% in 2010.
- At least 65% of students meet or exceed state science standards on the MSP science test, an increase from 56% in 2010.

School Description & Plans to Achieve Goals

North Beach is a small neighborhood K-5 school with a focus on academic achievement and a culture of inclusive caring through being safe, kind and productive. We believe that our students can accomplish anything they desire through hard work and a positive attitude—our mantra is “North Beach Seals model excellence!” and indeed we strive to do so on a daily basis. We also have a dedicated staff and a strong supportive community that serve our 345 students.

To achieve the above goals, we will be using Measures of Academic Progress, Measures of Student Progress and other data sources to monitor students according to their academic level in reading, writing and math and then strategically teach them to support and challenge their growth throughout the year. Teachers meet in grade level teams monthly to establish measurable goals and collaborate about the most effective strategies to increase student achievement. Additionally, tutors and volunteers are working with students who require extra support. North Beach also offers an aligned Saxon **math** program where students in grades 1 through 5 are placed into instructional groups according to their skill level during our 75 minute math block. Student **writing** will also be measured and assessed through the Houghton Mifflin and Writer’s Workshop program at least three times this year and teachers will review the writing samples and assessments to inform their instructional practice. Science instruction is also a focus and we will be committed to allocating our resources to support our students and staff as we are mindful in our approach to address our latest scores. As a learning community North Beach is looking at ways to align best instructional practices across grade levels. **Attendance** in school is a critical component to academic success and families will be encouraged to increase our attendance percentages this year.
